

## INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS

### Religious Education Coordinator or Facilitating teacher

#### Key Tasks

*Promote and advertise the opportunity for students to participate*

- Print the digital poster file and display around the school
- Distribute student information sheet to students or parents/guardians, as required
- Advise teaching staff about the festival to raise awareness

*Film selection*

- Once all submissions are received by Thursday 2 September 2021, facilitate the decision making process for film selection. Only three entries per school are permitted. It is recommended that several staff view the films, to determine which entries will represent their school and advance to the next level. Schools with many submissions are encouraged to create their own small event to help determine the three finalists of this festival.
- Submit entries on behalf of your school by Tuesday 5 October 2021. The google form and instructions will be provided closer to the student submission date.
- Each entry should include the film and a description (maximum of 50 words)

*Progressing to awards event*

- REC and principal will be advised of finalists. Consider a message from the principal for all notifications (advancement or acknowledgement of contribution)

## Technical details

- Each film to be between 30 seconds and 3 minutes
- To ensure authenticity of the filmmaking process, use of templates such as flipogram/ video star etc will not be considered as an entry in this competition.

## Copyright Information

Due to the online nature of the festival, all content used must be original, or copyright free. This [FAQ](#) resource can be used as a guide.

What is copyright free:

- An original student composition
- An arrangement of a prayer, where the author passed away over 75 years ago, set to original music.
- Music accessed from a royalty free website, eg [Bensound](#) or YouTube's [Audio Library](#), [Purple Planet Music](#), [MIXKIT](#), [CREATIVE COMMONS](#)

What is not copyright free:

- Taking an existing song and using it as background music in a slide presentation or film.
- Taking an existing song and performing it on video.
- Taking an existing song, editing it, and using it for an original dance.

## Media Consent

Videos submitted for this competition may be published publically online by Sydney Catholic Schools ('SCS') and the Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney ('CAS') on websites including, but not limited to, the SCS, CAS and CASPA websites and social media websites such as YouTube, Facebook and LinkedIn.

Any student that appears in a video must have a completed [Media Consent Form](#) on their school file or the entry will be deemed as invalid. This form would have been completed on enrolment to the school.

When registering the students' videos for the next level (judging), schools need to ensure that all students filmed have a completed Media Consent Form on file.

## Publishing of student names online

If it is indicated on any Media Consent Form that additional consent is required before publishing a student's name, schools need to enquire with the student and their parents/guardians as to their consent to the student's name being published online along with the film. Any consent should be obtained in writing.

## Consent of others participating in the video

It is important for the students to obtain the explicit consent of the other people participating in the video before commencing the recording and submitting the video for the competition.

Students to ensure they inform the other people participating in the video that the purpose of the video is for a competition run by SCS and it may be published online.

Any SCS student participating in the video should be given a copy of the Student Information Sheet.

Students to ensure they are respectful when recording other people.

## Awards Event

An awards ceremony will be held to recognise the talent of film makers who reach the finalist stage. Invitations to all finalists and guests from the school community. The event will also be live streamed.
