Ukrainian Displaced Persons in Australia Available Statistics



As at early May 2022, over 7,000 visas were issued and there were ~2,700 arrivals from Ukraine

Of those arrivals, >1,000 settled in NSW (>800 VIC, >500 QLD, >80 WA remainder in other states & territories)

AFUO has a central national database of Displaced Persons (DPs) requesting assistance (accommodation & other help) through Ukrainians.org.au

Our database does not capture all the arrivals as some people have family in Australia and may not require the community's assistance

E.g. As at 20 April 2022, our database contained a total of 441 (NSW 159) accommodation requests and a total of 2,447 (NSW 813) accommodation offers. Those numbers will continue to increase as more DPs arrive = 7000 beds

Community Support for Ukraine's Displaced Persons over the last six weeks

➤ required because of russia's torturous genocide of Ukraine (Day 71)



Each state's key Community association are members of Australian Federation of Ukrainian Organisations & work closely with us. All have:

- Arranged at each International airport a greeting in Ukrainian with information of how to connect with us and get assistance
- Established a network of volunteers to be able to assist Displaced Persons on a day to-day basis
- Approached Government and educational sectors for assistance | applied for grants to employ full time staff to support the DP's
- Published directories with information on Ukrainian places of worship, community centres and organisations
- Established a network of short term "free of charge" medical, dental, and other professional services
- Established weekly "meet & greets" to provide a warm environment to meet each other and the wider Australian and Australian - Ukrainian community | held community picnics and play days
- Established English language classes for all ages – community volunteer educators run these programs
- Provided emergency financial support when required
- Established clothes hubs and the gifting of new bedding, towels, and personal items
- Some states and parishes have been able to provide a small cash gift
- Held multiple fundraiser for humanitarian aid
- Run ongoing public protest to raise awareness and call on Australia & Corporate Australia to #StandWithUkraine and defeat russia!

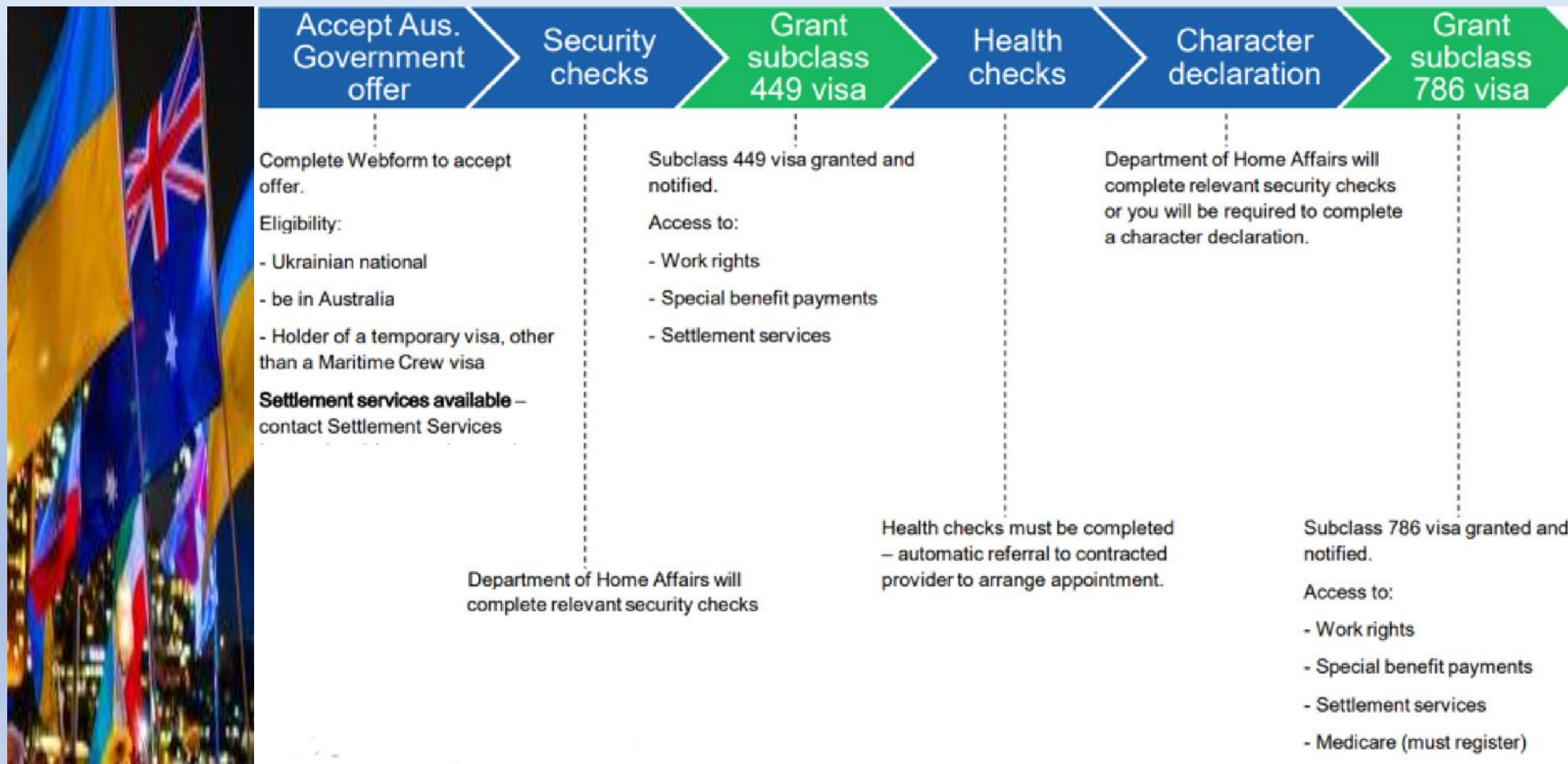
Ukrainians – Accepting the Australian Government offer of a temporary humanitarian stay in Australia

The majority of **Ukrainian Displaced Persons** have arrived on a **600 Visa**. This was an emergency initiative of the Australian Government to quickly get Ukrainians out of the dangers of war and into a safe environment, Visas were being approved within hours.

- The 600 visa has no entitlements
- Entitlements provided are at the states discretion e.g. schooling for children has been offered on this visa
